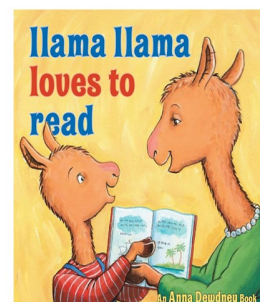
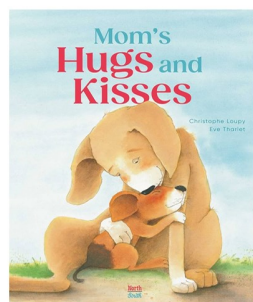

Story time will be held in the children's section of the library. Ages birth - 5 but all ages are welcome!

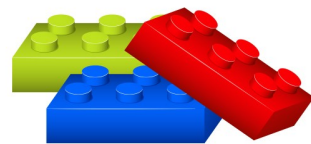
