All ages are welcome. Parental discretion is advised. There is no admission fee!

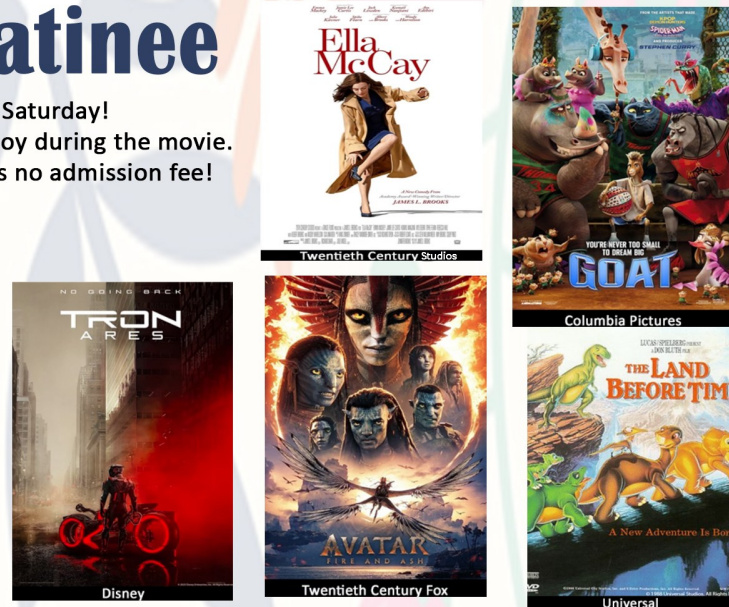
