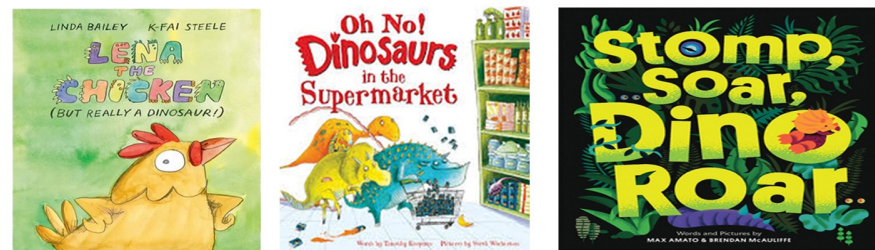

Saturday Movie Matinee

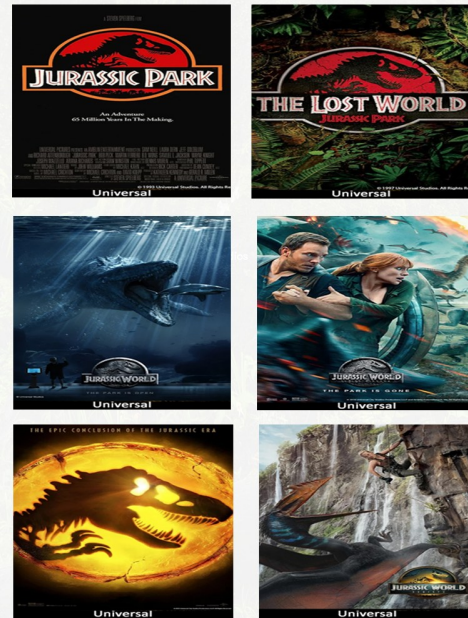
The movie will begin in the library auditorium every Saturday!

"Everyone knows the story of "the girl from Widow Hills."

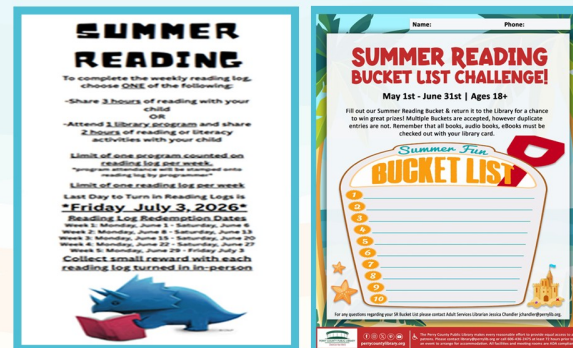
